

#### Re-enrollment Information

St Michael Catholic School's administration and staff are already looking ahead and making plans for next school year.

To complete the online enrollment process, you will access our Student Information System (SIS) through the Facts Family Portal, previously referred to as Parent Web. If you do not have an existing Parent Web account, please follow the Instructions for Creating a Family Portal Login listed below. Otherwise use the following steps to login the Family Portal:

- Please go to www.factsmgt.com
- Enter STMC-NC into the District Code field.
- Select Parent Login at the top of the page and select Facts Family Portal (ParentWeb) from the drop-down menu.
- Type in your username and password. If you have forgotten your username or password, please click on the link provided.
- After logging in, select Family from the menu list on the left.
- Select enrollment/Reenrollment. You will see an enrollment packet for each student in your family.
- Select Open (edit)Our Online Enrollment.
- Please follow the instructions listed in the first menu item.

The re-enrollment forms will be populated with the data we have on file. The online process should take approximately 15 minutes to update and complete. Your information will be saved if you need to quit and come back later. Since we are planning on using text, voice, and email communication channels in the future, please validate you home and cell phone numbers and email addresses along with the other required information. The Instructions and Enrollment Checklist page of the enrollment packet contains supplemental enrollment forms that also must be submitted if required.

Instructions for Creating a Family Portal Login

- Please go to www.factsmgt.com
- Select Parent Login at the top of the page and select Facts Family Portal (Parents Web) from the drop-down menu.
- When the RenWeb Family Portal Login screen opens, select Create New Family Portal Account.
- Enter STMC-NC into the District Code field.
- Enter your email address as provided in your application to the school.
- Select Create Account. You will receive an email from Facts Customer Support containing a link that will allow you to create your username and password. For security purposes a link will only be sent if your email is registered in Renweb and will remain active for 6 hours. Please click on the link. A Change/Create Password screen will open.
- You may use the default username provided or create a new username. Then type in your desired password into the Password and Confirm boxes.
- Click on the Save Username and/or Password button.
- Close the window.Log into the Family Portal as instructed above.
